Select your set of subjects carefully

Information

- Students need to study at least 12 Units in the Preliminary Year Program (Year 11)
- English is the only compulsory course
- HSC and Australian Tertiary Admissions Rank (ATAR) Pathway students need to do at least three (3) subjects (6 units) from the Board Developed Courses.
- Only one VET course can be counted towards your ATAR (by sitting the HSC exam for the course)
- Board Endorsed subjects are not externally examined and do not count towards an ATAR
- Students must complete the subject preference sheet

Instructions

- 1. Decide which pathway you wish to undertake: HSC with ATAR or HSC without an ATAR
- 2. Use the loose leaf sheets as a guide for your choice of subjects
- 3. Select the English course you wish to undertake
- 4. Write down in priority order the subjects in which you wish to be enrolled
- 5. Bring your completed subject preferences form to your subject selection interview
- 6. Return the signed subject selection document to the Curriculum Coordinator/Careers Adviser (Ms Wykes) or the Front Office

The school will use the priority order of subjects and the information regarding completing the HSC and obtaining an ATAR to provide the set of subjects which best meet the requirements of the students in this year.

If a student selects subjects which result in them having fewer than 12 units from the subjects that will run at Yass High School in Year 11 for 2020, the student will be interviewed to select alternative subjects.

You must have at least 10 units of Board Developed Courses, one of which can be a Vocational Educational Training (VET) Course requiring a Higher School Certificate (HSC) exam to gain an Australian Tertiary Admissions Rank (ATAR)
